

Order on charges for registration of rights to aircraft etc.

In pursuance of § 3 of the Act on Registration of Rights to Aircraft, cf. Consolidation Order no. 620 of 15 September 1986 as amended by Act no. 396 of 13 June 1990 and by Act no. 1088 of 23 December 1992, and on the authority of the Ministry of Transport, the following is stipulated:

§ 1. For registration of rights to aircraft as mentioned in numbers 2 and 3 of § 2 of the Act on Registration of Rights to Aircraft, a charge of DKr. 3310 shall be paid.

§ 2. The charge shall be paid for each individual document for which registration is applied and which is to be entered in the day list.

§ 3. If registration of a document is refused, no new charge shall be paid if registration of the document is applied for again within 3 months calculated from the first application for registration.

§ 4. Exempt from payment of charge is registration of:

- 1) changes of address,
- 2) legal incapacity and guardianship, f. subsection (3) of § 1 of the Act on Registration of Rights to Aircraft,
- 3) notifications as mentioned in § 11 of the Act on Registration of Rights to Aircraft,

- 4) deprivation of the right of disposal in pursuance of § 26 of the Bankruptcy Act and
- 5) equitable lien.

(2) Exempt from payment of charge is also request for

- 1) removal,
- 2) annulment of a note,
- 3) extension of respite or final entry in the Register of Rights to Aircraft of a document that is registered with a respite, and
- 4) removal of rights that have not obtained coverage in connection with compulsory sale, cf. § 581 of the Administration of Justice Act.

§ 5. For certificates, transcripts, authenticated copies, photo copies or the like that are drawn up by the Register of Rights to Aircraft, a charge of DKr. 905 shall be paid per document.

§ 6. The charge falls due for payment when application for registration of the document is made, or when a certificate, transcript, authenticated copy, photocopy etc. is ordered.

§ 7. This Order shall enter into force on 1 February 2009.

(2) At the same time Order no. 452 of 21 May 2007 on charges for registration of rights to aircraft is repealed.
